Dear Parents / Guardians,

A booklist for the kindergarten students has been compiled in preparation for the beginning of the 2025 school year.

Your child will require the following stationery items:

- 1 x packet of green dishwashing sponges (5 pack of Woolworths or Coles own brand)
- 1 x box of tissues
- 3 x 0.6 Artline fine liner markers
- 1 x packet of black whiteboard markers
- 3 x UHU glue stick

Your child will require the following personal items:

- drink bottle
- lunchbox
- Kearnan College school hat
- Kearnan College school uniform (please refer to school website for further details)
- Kearnan College school bag
- Kearnan College library bag
- 1 x spare t-shirt, shorts/trousers, underwear and socks (in case of toileting accident or messy play)
- 1 x plastic bag for spare clothing
- 1 x rest cushion (no larger than approximately 30 cm x 30 cm)

Although stationery items do not need to be labelled, please ensure all personal items, including spare clothes, are labelled with your child's full name. There are many second-hand school t-shirts and jumpers available from the uniform shop however, many of them may have other children's names on them. If you have second-hand items, please remember to rename them with your child's name.

I understand that the first day of school may be a very busy experience, so please do not feel the need to bring all the booklist items to school at once.

On their first day, the children will need the following personal items: school uniform, hat, school bag, drink bottle and a packed lunchbox. The remaining stationery items can come in later, during the first or second week of the term.
